Read Psalm 122

1. Why do think David wrote into the Psalms, "I rejoiced with those who said to me, 'Let us go to the house of the Lord'"?
2. What do you think is the significance of those words to us as a body of believers at EVC today and to you personally?
 - This week, read 2 Samuel 5 & 6 to learn how David rejoiced when he brought the Ark of the Covenant into Jerusalem.

In the New Living Translation Bible, Psalm 122:3 says, "Jerusalem is a well-built city, knit together as a single unit."

3. How has your small group become a well-built city knit together as a single unit? What about EVC?
4. What can you do to build stronger unity in your small group unit? How about in our Church body?
 - This week review 1 Peter 2, to understand a deeper truth about the "spiritual house" of God.
5. What is the significance of becoming part of this spiritual house?
 - This week, read and meditate on Revelations 21, to learn how God, on "that day" will create a new heaven and earth and a new Jerusalem. The Holy City, and God's dwelling place will once again be with His people. Be encouraged by God's word today!
