Read Psalm 123

4. Tim spoke of how we each need to acknowledge God is God, admit we have needs and He is sufficient to handle them, and accept His generosity and mercy. Which of these three steps do you struggle with most?
5. Read John 3:31-36 about Jesus. How does this fit with Tim's teaching about our need to acknowledge, admit, and accept?

This week read 2 Chronicles chapters 19 & 20, the story of Jehoshaphat, King of Judah and how he looked at God's hand when faced with a great need, Jehoshaphat accepted God's direction, protection, and provision.
