1. Based on the following scriptures, make a list of some of the spiritual gifts mentioned: **(1 Corinthians 12, Romans 12:1-8, Ephesians 4:11-16, 1 Peter 4:9-10)**  
Here is one list in alphabetical order: Administration, Apostleship, Discernment, Encouragement, Evangelism, Faith, Giving, Healing, Helping, Hospitality, Interpretation, Knowledge, Leadership, Mercy, Miracles, Pastoring, Prophecy, Teaching, Tongues, and Wisdom.
2. Which Spiritual gifts do you feel God has given you?  
Some may know others may need to think and pray about it. You and your group may be able to help individuals see the gifts based upon how they are serving in the body currently.

3. In what way is God asking you to use your Spiritual gifts?
