

God Is Almighty:

During this series we will be looking at who God is. This week we will see how God is Almighty. Meaning that He is great and all-powerful and His will has no limits. God is so much bigger than any problem, any obstacle, any battle or anything that I could even imagine.

This Weeks Memory Verse: Psalm 46:10-11

*"Be still, and know that I am God;
I will be exalted among the nations,
I will be exalted in the earth."
The LORD Almighty is with us;
the God of Jacob is our fortress. Selah*

Exodus 6:1 says, *"Then the LORD said to Moses, 'Now you will see what I will do to Pharaoh: Because of my mighty hand he will let them go; because of my mighty hand he will drive them out of his country.'"*

- What do the words of God from Exodus 6:1, tell you about His Almighty power?"

That God's almighty powerful hand will overturn even the most powerful and determined enemies to surrender to him. When God wants to do something nothing can stop him.

- The freeing of the Israelites (Exodus 3-17) was an amazing show of God's power and how His Almighty hand will bring about His will and no one can stop Him. What are some other stories from the Bible that clearly reveal that God is Almighty and unstoppable?

I think of the invincible walls of Jericho tumbling down simply by the power of the praises to God. I think of how God kept the fiery flames from harming Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego. How God empower David and his men to win battle after battle. How God created the heavens and earth by the sound of his voice. How by the Almighty hand of God, the demons are cast away, the sick are healed, the blind see, the lame walk and the dead rise to life. That is an Almighty God.

Daily Scripture Meditation Reading:

God's Almighty power reveled in the Psalms

- Day 1: Psalm 9
- Day 2: Psalm 24
- Day 3: Psalm 46
- Day 4: Psalm 135
- Day 5: Psalm 145

- How has reading from the Psalms this week revealed that God is Almighty?

Ask people to share and give them a chance to articulate what they read from God's word.

- What does the truth that God is Almighty mean to you personally?

To me this truth reminds me that I can put my trust in Him. That if God is almighty what do I have to worry about. As the word says, "What then shall we say in response to this? If God is for us, who can be against us?" Romans 8:31

- How has God shown you that He is Almighty in your life?

Ask people to share. Sometimes we forget the overwhelming power of God in healing, in miracles, even in the giving of life. I have seen God perform some amazing healings as a result of calling on him in prayer. Of course if we choose we can say it was by chance, or by medical technology, or maybe an incorrect diagnosis but I call it the power of the almighty. I have prayed with people who for years could not have a baby, trying all kinds of medical treatments and then by intervention of the almighty power of the creator of life, they have a baby and then a few years later they have another.

- How should that affect the way you face challenges of life?

Ultimately, having an Almighty God should move us to trust him and quit worrying and fretting about the future. We shouldn't be afraid of anything. I should spend a lot more time on my knees trusting and calling on the Lord for help.

- What should this truth lead you to do in your daily walk with God?

Pray more! Trust more! Be confident. As the memory verse indicates, I should learn be still and know that He is God!

*Who is he, this King of glory?
The LORD Almighty— he is the King of glory. Selah Psalm 24:10*

Discovering God Is Almighty

Read and journal your thoughts from Psalm 145:3-4

*Great is the LORD and most worthy of praise;
his greatness no one can fathom.
One generation will commend your works to another;
they will tell of your mighty acts.
They will speak of the glorious splendor of your majesty,
and I will meditate on your wonderful works.*

What do these verses tell you about God the Almighty?

You may want to ask people if they would like to share what these words revealed to them.

How should this truth lead you in response toward God?

Let people share. One thing I see is that if I will look at God's mighty acts it will lead me into worship. For example when I reflect on some of the great biblical things he has done, or when I walk in the beauty of creation, along the ocean shores or in the mountains I am at awe with our God and I can't help but worship him.
