

## God is Salvation:

### This Weeks Memory Verse: Psalm 32:1

*“Blessed is he whose transgressions are forgiven, whose sins are covered.”*

- Read and Meditate on 2 Corinthians 5:17-21

We have been reconciled to God through Christ Jesus our Lord! What an amazing truth. Take a moment and ponder that thought. Think for a moment about the idea that, “God made him who had no sin to be sin for us so that we could become the righteousness of God.”

What words come to mind that you wish to express to God in appreciation and praise as a response to the message of reconciliation?

Ask people to share.

I need to take a deep hard look at the truth that by no doing of my own God devised a plan to reconcile me. He did that out of love. I need to rejoice and shout out loud, “Thank you God!”

What reaction should this message stir up in you?

I should be so excited about this message of reconciliation to God that I can't hold it in. I want to shout it from the roof tops, from the highest mountains, to the people everywhere. I have a message that is so great I can't keep it in.

### Daily Scripture Meditation Reading:

God our salvation revealed in the Psalms

- How has reading from the Psalms this week revealed that God is your Salvation?

Over and over again I see that God reaches out to his people whom cry out for help and he rescues and redeems. The Psalms show me that we have a God of salvation. A God of second chances. A God who loves me and refuses to leave me in the pit.

- What does the truth that God is your salvation mean to you personally?

I can live free and live life to its fullest. I cannot pay God back nor do I need to. But because of His great love for me I am compelled to share it with the world.

➤ How has salvation affected your life?

It has given me freedom from fear, freedom from worry, freedom from guilt and regret. Salvation changes who I am. I become a new creation, not just spiritually but humanly as well. The way I live my life is a testimony of the truth that I have been reconciled to God and nothing can ever change that. I am convinced that nothing can separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

➤ What should this truth lead you to do in your daily walk with God?

I should live my life as one who has been rescued and can't wait to tell others about my rescuer.

### Discovering God Is Salvation

#### Read and journal your thoughts from Psalm 130

<sup>1</sup> Out of the depths I cry to you, O LORD; <sup>2</sup> O Lord, hear my voice. Let your ears be attentive to my cry for mercy. <sup>3</sup> If you, O LORD, kept a record of sins, O Lord, who could stand? <sup>4</sup> But with you there is forgiveness; therefore you are feared. <sup>5</sup> I wait for the LORD, my soul waits, and in his word I put my hope. <sup>6</sup> My soul waits for the Lord more than watchmen wait for the morning, more than watchmen wait for the morning. <sup>7</sup> O Israel, put your hope in the LORD, for with the LORD is unfailing love and with him is full redemption. <sup>8</sup> He himself will redeem Israel from all their sins.
