Lesson:

Read Psalm 95 (A call to worship)

- Why do you think God invites us to worship Him?

God wants worshipers. The Bible is crystal clear about that matter. Our God is a jealous God and will not let His worship go to any other Gods.

And God designed us to be worshipers. He designed worship as a means for us to experience His presence. I also know that we experience peace and joy when we truly worship God. God knows that it is through worship that we come into His presence and it is through His presence that we find peace, joy and purpose.

- Does it seem self serving that God calls us to worship Him?

Many would say yes. I would say, He is God and He can do whatever He chooses. He decided to give me life, He can choose to make my life for whatever purpose He had planned. Why does the created feel able to tell the creator what is right and wrong? I always go back to the doxology in Romans 11:33-36 when confronted with these type of questions. Read Romans 11:33-36 in light of this question.

Besides, God knows what is best and He knows it is best for us to be worshipers. He knows that a relationship with Him is the best thing in life period!

- What do you personally experience when you worship God?

Focus in on this question and ask people to share their worship experience.

You may want to have people share what they took away from reading Psalm 95 this week.
