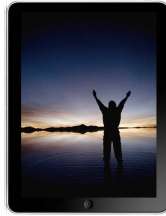


Psalm 150

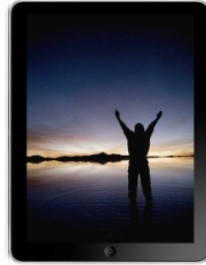
